Advancement & Adventure Week at Many Point Scout Camp

Is your crew or troop planning a unique high adventure expedition or a trip to Philmont? Do you have Scouts or Venturers who have a strong interest in emergency services and what to take their training to the next level? Now is your chance to sign them up for a great program offering at Many Point Scout Camp.



For one week only (July 12 - 18), Many Point will be offering its "All Things Emergency Response" Advancement and Adventure Week. This is not a typical week with the troop or crew – program will be focused entirely on how to deal with emergency situations. This is a great chance for your Scouts and Venture Scouts to earn and do the following:

- Complete Red Cross Wilderness First Aid*
- Finish a nationally recognized CPR certification
- Earn Emergency Preparedness & Safety Merit Badges
- Participate in simulated air, land, and water emergency scenarios (including *Climbing Rescues*, *Air Plane Crashes*, *Open Water Survival*, and *Unique Wilderness Survival Techniques*)
- Work side by side with the local Sheriff's Department and Search & Rescue teams to practice their skills
- Contribute to a team environment with a themed base camp where training and missions are assigned.



Participants must be qualified as swimmers, be at least 15 years old, and be in good physical health. Similar to the All-Star program, Scouts can sign up as individuals and we will provide staff to serve as the adult leadership. Program space is extremely limited so sign up early.

Return the registration below, with \$25.00, to reserve your spot. The balance is due by June 1. The **All Things Emergency Response** fee is \$250.00 for the week. This includes all instruction, equipment, meals and program. The fee does not include transportation to camp. The Scout office, at your request, can provide a list of the other participants attending the **All Things Emergency Response** program for carpooling. Check-in is between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 12. **A completed camp physical form is required.**

* Certification in this course will meet the new medical requirements for Philmont Expeditions.

The program must have a minimum of 7 participants to function. If the minimum is not reached participant fees will be refunded.
